The design of the levels of the plan are on a straight pedestrian/vehicular semicontinuous, creating an area type hybrid "Woonerf", in which the image defines a "calm traffic area". The central area in Cuasso stone is kept as it is like historical stratification of the design of the square, as memory to the contemporary city and the merged frame granite with the new paving reduces the centrality of Portoghesi original design. The new flooring gives the material continuity in the entire area of the project, done with the same material of the stone frame.
