The square is the collector between the Central park and the Shopping mall of Akasya Acibadem. Is not only an area to cross but a social and wellbeing place, where functional and visual relations are created. The project foresees the creation of a space people-oriented, dimensioned by proportional relations between plan and elevations. The square is a place that create identities and relationships, a collector for different activities; a space where grown-up the accessibility and visibility of shops.

The design of urban furniture have had important roles: aesthetic, functional and especially is a climate controller.

In this area the wind caused the strong currents and often it was not possible to stay outdoor. The green spots with trees and shrubs of different sizes arrest the wind allowing users to use the outdoor spaces. Through a software simulation of the wind it is possible to verify the actual benefit given by the introduction of plant elements in the square.

The study of urban furniture, the use of green spaces and adequate lighting, makes the square a pleasant place to stay.
